50	<b>Formiga De Galena 2011, Priorat, Spain</b> <i>Formiga de galena is a wine with a cherry red colour, intense, it has a complex aroma where red and black fruits stand out, combined with balsamic and spicy notes</i>	30
51	<b>Domaine Armand, Côtes Du Rhône, 2012, Rhône, France</b> <i>The semi-opaque, Dense, rich boysenberry and black raspberry show in both the nose and the mouth, finishing dry. This is a straightforward, well-balanced, fruit rich wine.</i>	35
52	<b>Velenosi, Lacrima, 2012, Di Morro D'Alba, Italy</b> <i>A lovely light fruit leaden wine with hints of lavender and rose water</i>	35
54	<b>Domaine Lathuiliere Gravallon, Fleurie, 2012, Beaujolais, France</b> <i>Pure and fresh, this Fleurie shows juicy cherry fruit combined with delicate</i>	35
55	<b>Belezos, Rioja, Reserva, 2008, Spain</b> <i>This Reserva offers a succulent iteration of this classic Rioja style. While respecting traditional structure, the wine is bursting with ripe, dark fruit balanced by complex savoury notes of leather and tobacco. A light top note of vanilla spice gives lift.</i>	45
56	<b>Château Trillol, 2011, Corbières, France</b> <i>This is one of the discoveries of the year. It's a great rustic red from the Cabieros region. A blend of Grenache, Syrah &amp; Carignan that shows some peppery spice on the nose and hints of cherry, cocoa and hedgerow fruits.</i>	40
57	<b>Domaine Lucien Jacob, Chambolle - Musigny, 2006, Côte D'Or, France</b> <i>Our Top wine maker and good friend Lucien Jacob bought us this lovely example of French Pinot Noir made just outside the small town of Nuits St George.</i>	60

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58	<p><b>Carmel Road, Pinot Noir, 2012, Monterey County, USA</b> <i>The cool climate of Monterey County produces an elegant and concentrated Pinot Noir. Dark cherries, white pepper and rose petals on the nose combine with the structured palate, ripe and fine tannins to produce a fresh, balanced wine that is sure to impress</i></p>	45
59	<p><b>Yarra Valley, Pinot Noir, Mac Forbes 2013, Australia</b> <i>This elegant wine reveals earthy, slightly savoury aromas with dark cherries and plums with a hint of spicy oak. The palate is medium bodied and delicately complex. It displays flavours of plum red berries, black cherry with soft tannins good length.</i></p>	50
60	<p><b>Terrasses Du Larzac, Calmel Joseph, 2012, France</b> <i>A special wine from this prized small area within the languedoc. A blend of mourvedre, syrah and grenache, this is an intense wine with cassi, herbs, liquorice and spice. Full, yet balanced and complex with mineral notes on the long finish</i></p>	55
61	<p><b>Hartenberg, Shiraz, 2011, Stellenbosch, South Africa</b> <i>Hardenberg's flagship wine. A voluptuous red with rich concentrated spice, Ripe plum fruit and big but smooth tannins</i></p>	45
62	<p><b>Fromm, Clayvin Vineyard, Pinot Noir, 2010, Marlborough, New Zealand</b> <i>100% pure Pinot Noir, this is a rich and plummy wine with subtle flavours of herbs and earth, perfectly balancing the generous fruit.</i></p>	70
63	<p><b>Domaine La Roquette, Château Neuf Du Pape, 2010, Rhône, France</b> <i>With 70% Grenache providing the sweet fruit and a balance of Syrah and Mourvèdre adding structure and a savoury note, this is richly textured with a silky tannic backdrop and an engagingly sweet and rounded finish.</i></p>	65
65	<p><b>PSI, Peter Sisseck, 2010, Ribera Duero, Spain</b> <i>This is an inviting, shimmering, plum-purple in colour, with a firm, bright rim. The nose offers an explosion of ripe, aromatic, black fruit, plum and black cherry compote, complemented by mineral notes. The palate is expansive, generous with abundant fruit, richly textured and bursting with personality.</i></p>	55

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67	<b>Château Les Ormes De Pez, 2009, St-Estèphe, Bordeaux</b> <i>With a violet, almost Pomerol character, the 2009 Ormes de Pez is a seductive, concentrated wine with ripe, juicy mulberry fruit and ultra-ripe tannins providing structure. A smooth, velvety mouthful and wonderful harmony on the palate make this a truly gorgeous wine</i>	65
68	<b>Costa Mediana, Amarone Della Valpolicella, 2011, Italy</b> <i>Never less than 14%, this is a big raisiny full bodied wine, low in acidity</i>	65
70	<b>Cakebread Cellars, Pinot Noir, 2011, Anderson Valley, USA</b> <i>Medium-bodied and supple on the palate, with fine tannins, the wine delivers juicy black cherry, red currant and black raspberry flavours that persist throughout a long, lively finish featuring bright acidity and a refreshing minerality</i>	90
71	<b>Château La Grave, Pomerol, 2006, France</b> <i>Pure crushed fruit on the nose, with raspberry, dark chocolate and berry. Full bodied with velvety tannins, a long finish and well balanced richness.</i>	95
73	<b>Domaine Geantet-Pansiot, Gevrey Chambertin, 2009, Côte D'Or, France</b> <i>Here the nose is much more reserved with ripe yet cool and airy black raspberry and red cherry liqueur aromas cut with distinct stony notes that also appear on the rich, intense and beautifully well-detailed flavours brimming with dry extract that renders the otherwise firm tannins almost invisible on the dusty, focused and Impeccably well balanced finish.
